

Serving at the Agape Academy In Ghana, West Africa

Thank you for your interest in serving with Agape Gospel Mission. We have two full-service orphanages for children who have lost both parents—one for boys and one for girls. Our main opportunity available at this time is for people who can commit to a period of nine months in Ghana to teach at the Agape Academy.

Teaching and tutoring the children in basic education

The Agape Academy is our on-site private school for Agape kids. Our school is providing a first-class education to our children in K-12 using the Abeka curriculum. A typical school day lasts from 9am till 1pm. Most of our children need extensive individual tutoring which can be done after school, or during off-days. We look for teachers that will have their own class, which requires you to stay the entire school year. The school year runs from early September through mid-June (rough estimation). If you wish to stay longer, even in the summer months there is a need for people to help with group remedial tutoring for individual children and small groups.

Experience in teaching is beneficial but not required. The most important things are to have a love for kids, a love for learning, and the ability to be firm and enforce rules when necessary.

Teaching and training in spiritual matters

We can discuss opportunities to conduct Bible studies, lead devotions, or assist in teaching Sunday School. You can be creative in this aspect, as the kids love to learn dramas, dances, and songs. Financial Considerations

Agape Gospel Mission is a volunteer ministry in which missionaries raise 100% of their support. We do everything in our power to keep costs low; however, it is not cheap living in a developing country. A single, short-term worker should be prepared to pay roughly \$40/day or \$1200/month in living expenses, which covers lodging, food, and transportation
