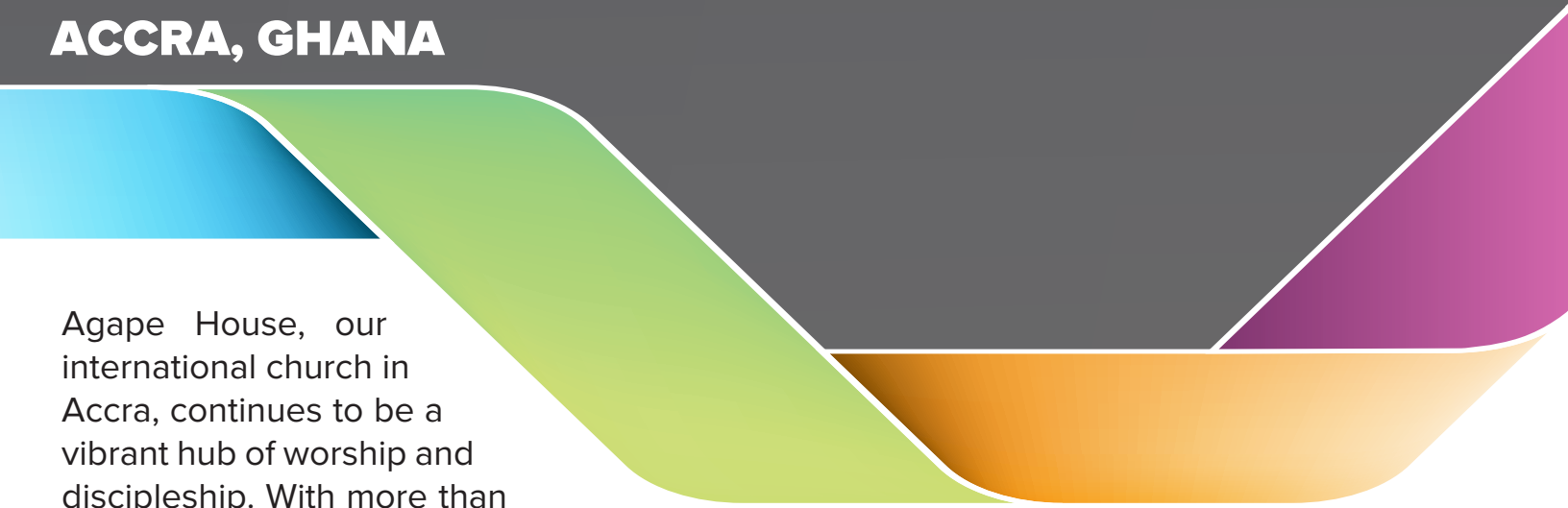

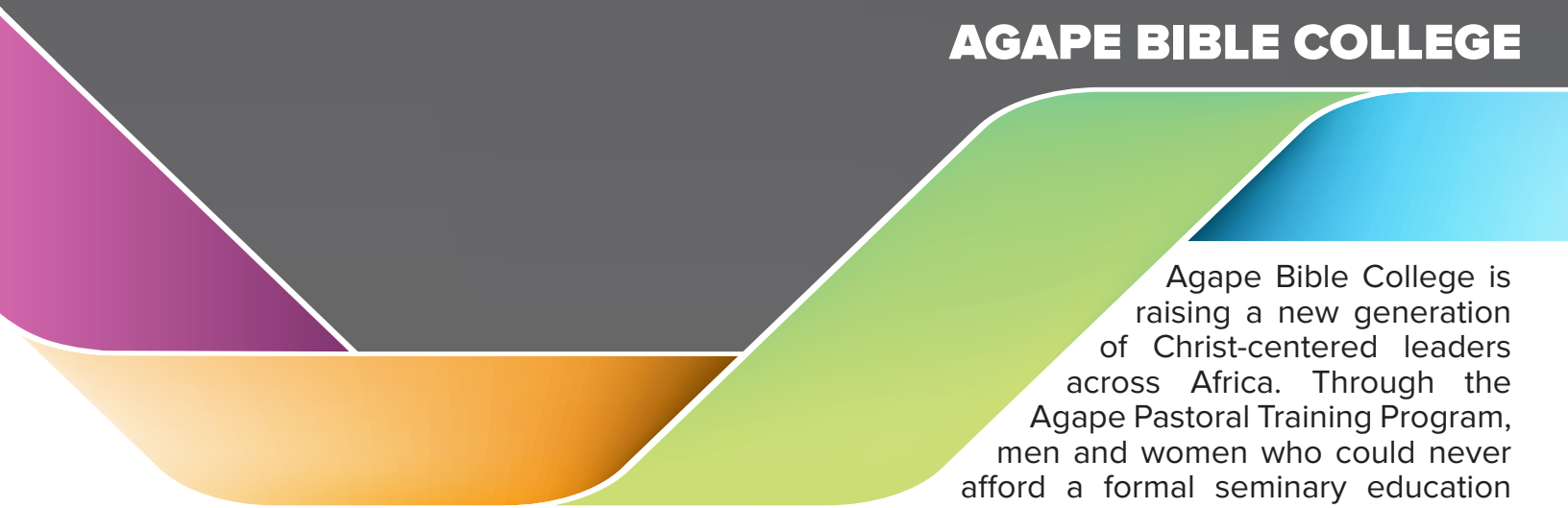

AGAPE BIBLE COLLEGE



Agape Bible College is raising a new generation of Christ-centered leaders across Africa. Through the Agape Pastoral Training Program, men and women who could never afford a formal seminary education receive accessible, high-quality biblical

training. As they grow in sound doctrine and the power of the Holy Spirit, these pastors are planting churches and transforming communities throughout Ghana, Nigeria, Benin, Zambia, South Sudan, Liberia, and Sierra Leone.

The Need to Sponsor:

Call to Action: Support a pastor by offering housing, food, and training.

Cost: \$50 per month.

Impact: Provides one year of training for a future church planter.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Agape Gospel Mission's conferences pour life and strength into pastors who are serving on the frontlines of the gospel. At our Lead and Ablaze gatherings, these faithful leaders encounter spiritual renewal through worship, prayer, and the fellowship of other believers. They receive biblical instruction, theological training and practical leadership tools that empower them to preach Christ with courage—even in hostile regions among tribes such as the Fulani. These retreats restore weary hearts and equip pastors to carry the hope of Jesus to the places that need Him most.

The Need to Sponsor:

Call to Action: Support a pastor in reaching the least evangelized communities.

Cost: \$250 per month.

Impact: Equips a pastor serving in hostile areas for one year.

CHURCH PLANTING

In persecuted nations such as Nigeria, Sierra Leone, and South Sudan, a physical church building is far more than bricks and cement—it is a bold declaration of faith in Jesus. It stands as a secure and visible sanctuary where believers can

worship freely and find refuge in Christ. These buildings also become lifelines for their communities, serving as hubs for crisis relief, education, healthcare, and practical support. In places marked by hardship, violence, and spiritual opposition, a church home brings stability, strength, and hope.

The Need to Sponsor:

Call to Action: Lay a foundation of hope and safety.

Cost: \$150,000 or \$5,000 per month.

Impact: Provides a safe, permanent home for persecuted believers.

Project: High School Building Loan Payoff

Impact: This final payment will secure a permanent, debt-free future for Christ-centered secondary education, allowing all resources to strengthen teachers, programs, and student opportunities.

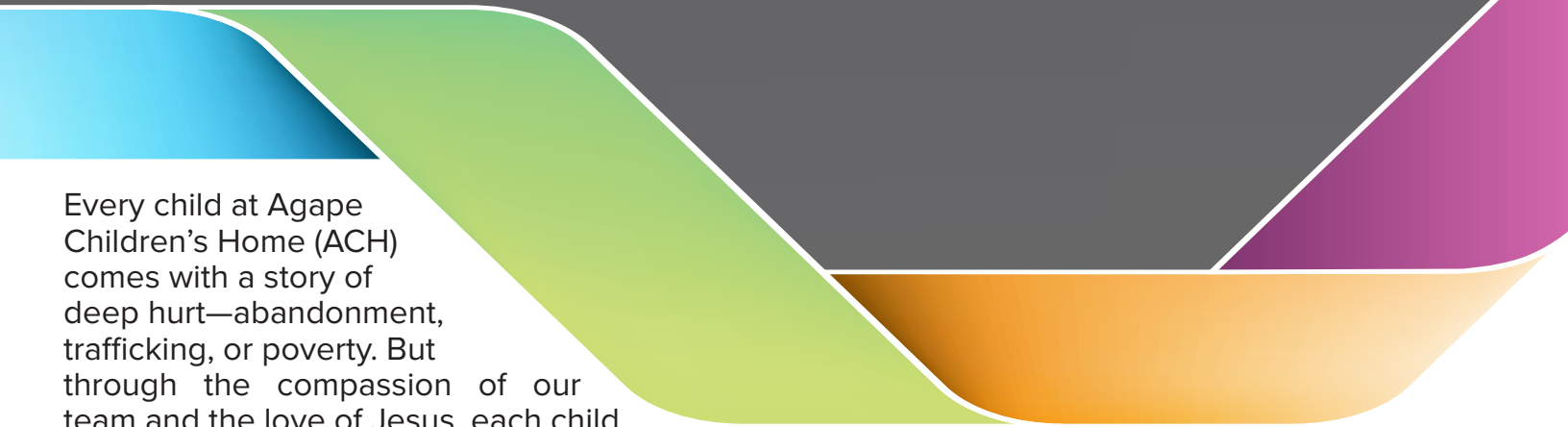
Cost: \$100,000

ACH provides safety, stability, and discipleship, meeting their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs so healing can take root. Today, more than 60 children are part of our ACH family. By God's grace, many former residents are now thriving as graduates, teachers, nurses, and skilled professionals.

RESCUING : SPONSORING : SAFE HOME

The Need: Rescue a Child

ACH Rescue Fund: Provides immediate safety, medical care, and trauma counseling for a child until a permanent sponsor is found.

Cost: \$25,000 (replenish the fund)
Call to Action: "Say 'Yes' when a child cries for help."

The Need: Sponsor a Child

Monthly Child Sponsorship: Provides full, holistic care—food, shelter, education, and love—for one child each month.

Cost: \$35 per month
Call to Action: "Change a life forever. Become a sponsor today."

The Need: A Safe Home

Building Maintenance & New Facilities: \$50,000 ensures a safe, well-maintained home for one year. A gift of \$10,000 furnishes a new dorm with beds for 25 new children.

Cost: \$60,000 (combined goal)
Call to Action: "Give the gift of a safe and comfortable home."
